Global challenges in the statistical follow-up

- Huge variety of data availability across the countries
 - Mature statistical systems indicate availability of data for around 30 per cent of the indicators. less mature systems indicate the same percentage. credible?
- Pattern of data flows still not decided. what will be the final role of the NSOs, International Agencies, FN Regional Bodies (UNECE) and non-official data producers?
- How do we target capacity-building?

Statistical annex to the Danish Voluntary National Review

- Short time for compilation necessitated some priorities:
 - Main focus on data available in Statistics Denmark;
 - Time series covering 2005-2015;
 - Where possible international comparability
 - Challenges
 - Still many indicators without a clear definition;
 - The global aspect of the indicators . not always fully relevant for Denmark;
 - Not so many comparable data across the countries. mainly EU. how can the global comparability be improved with time?

Way ahead (1)

- The next steps for producing global data for Denmark:
 - Thorough mapping of data availability building on the one conducted in 2016;
 - Establishing an IT platform for data reporting;
 - Clarification whether Statistics Denmark should be the contact point for data requests from International Agencies (preferable);
 - Discussions and consultations on the shape of the next report (we are aiming at state of the art);

Way ahead (2)

- Clarification of data flows in Denmark;
- Dialogue with non-official data producers in order to ensure a broader data coverage in Denmark;
- Cooperation on Nordic reporting;
- International involvement . targeting and contributing to concrete work on international level.
